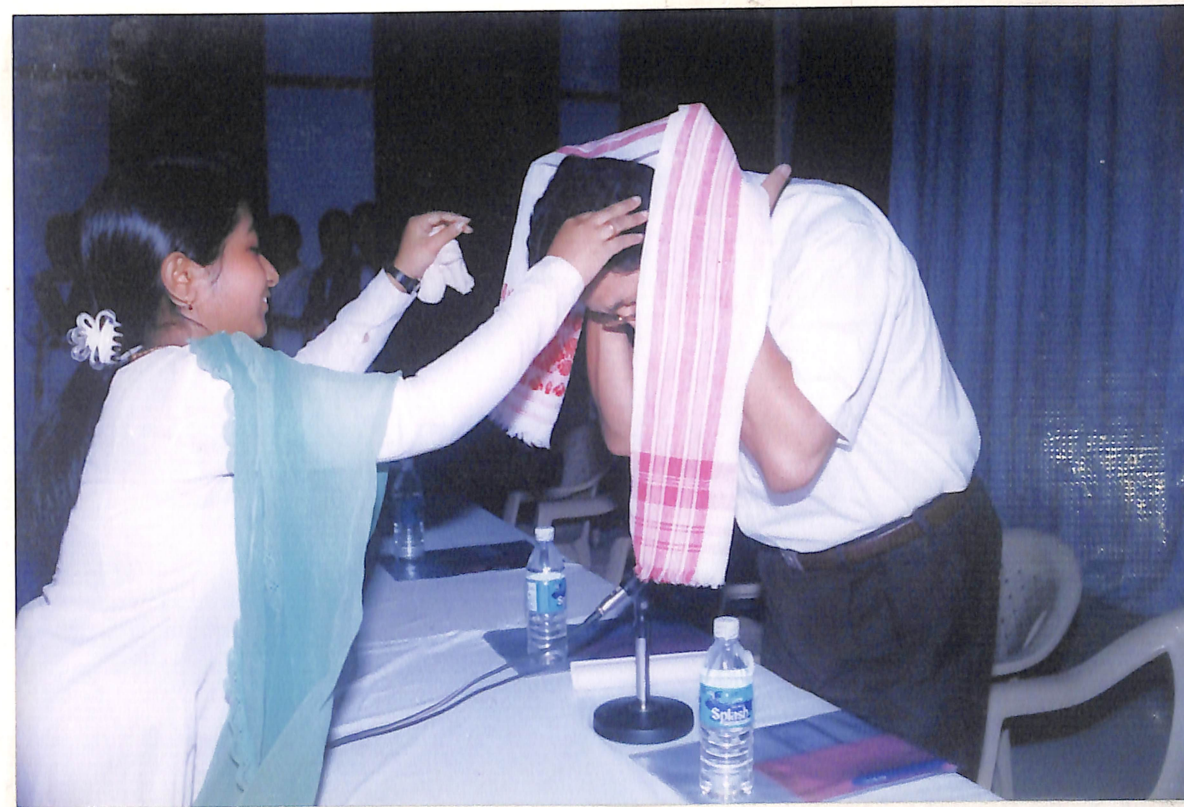

- Another major objective of the symposium was to impart knowledge regarding the various finance schemes and provisions which are increasingly made available by the STPD in collaboration with OIL for generating self employment.
- A drama named 'Alookor Sandhanat' was also staged on the 10th Nov 2004 by the students of the college. The central theme of the drama being, 'Women's Education - its importance'.
- The broad objectives of staging the drama are stated overleaf.

3. One of the immediate objectives was Personality Development of the college students through stage performance and Public speeches.

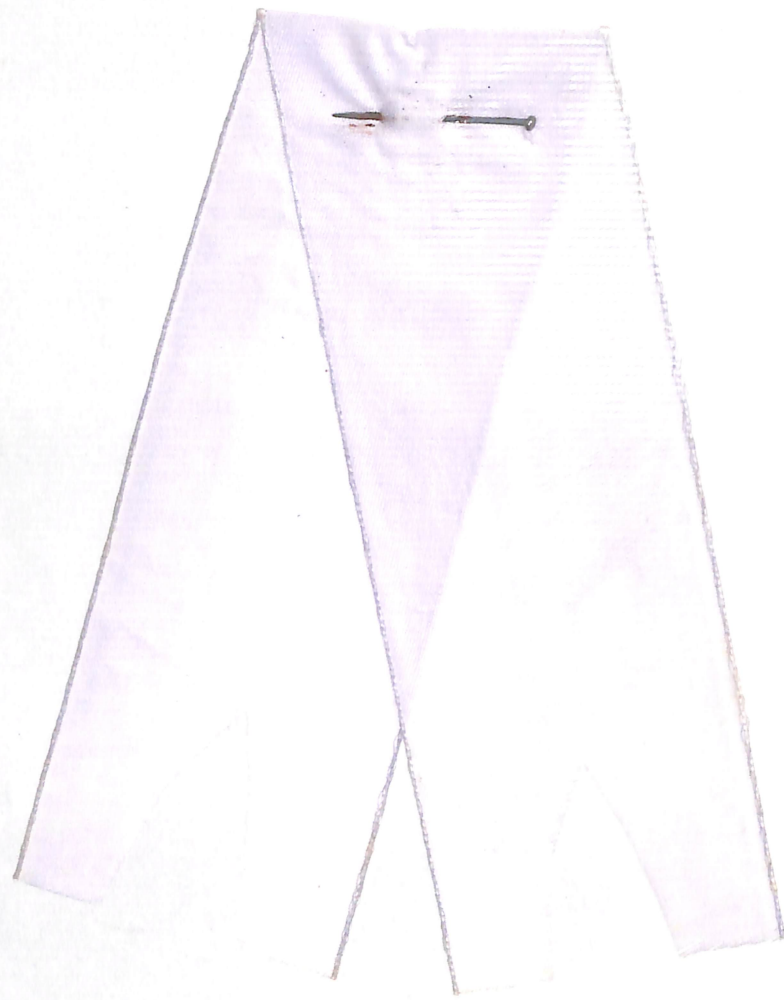



GENERAL OBJECTIVES:

- Create awareness regarding maintenance of good health among girls
- Provide information regarding blood group
- Detection of diseases, followed by counselling to Guardians of the wards by doctors from ICMR

SPECIFIC OBJECTIVES:

- Collection of blood samples for
- Blood group determination
 - Presence of anaemia
 - Presence of any other disease like Thalaesemia, low blood platelates etc.
