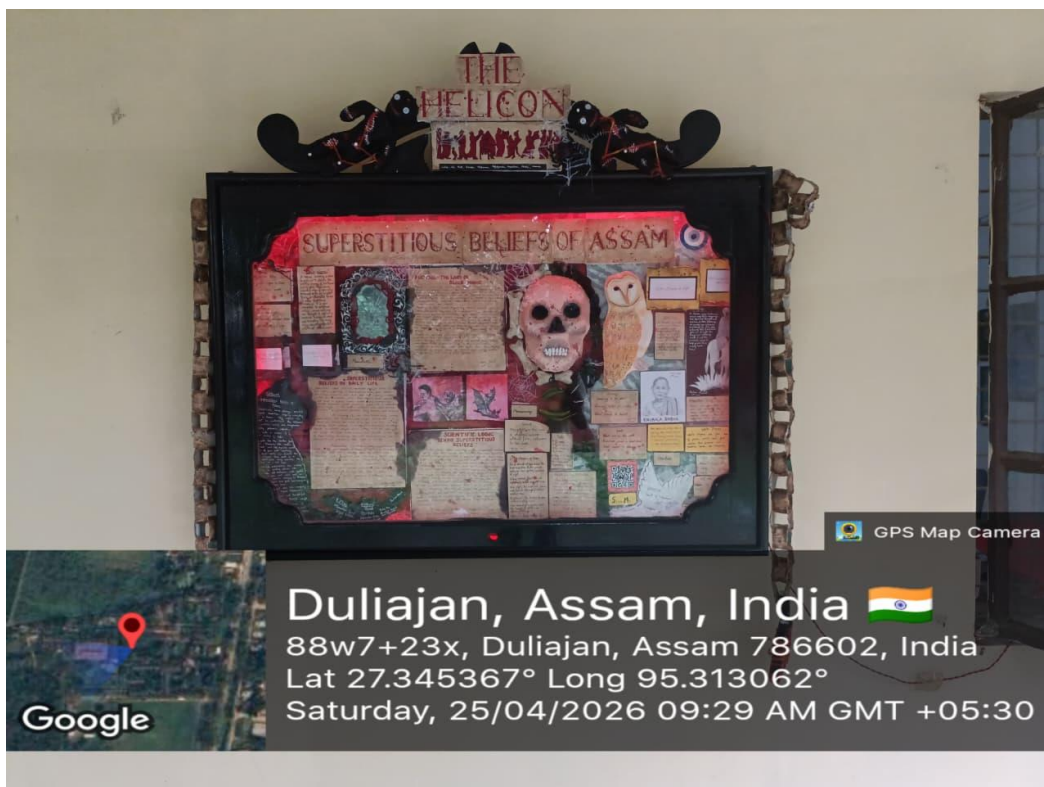

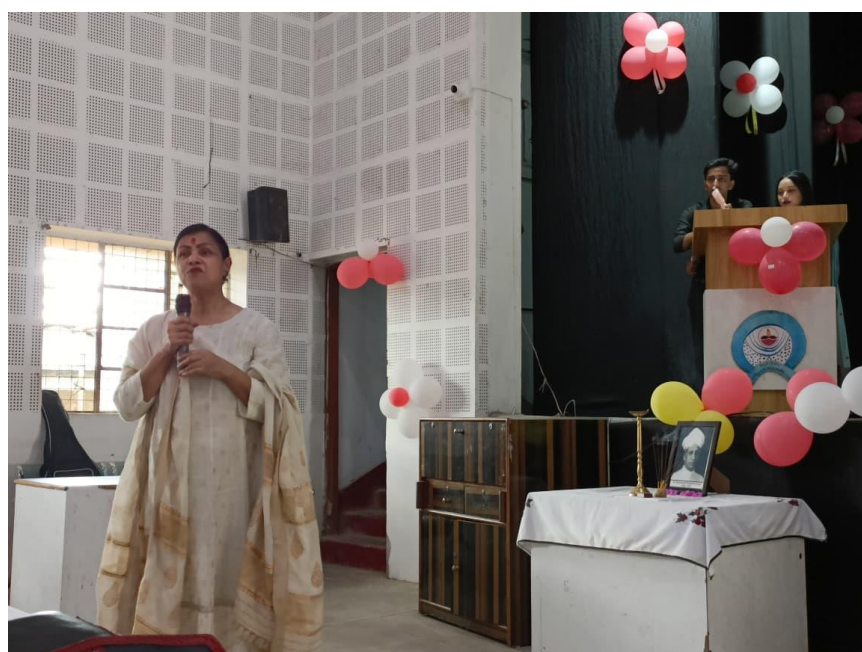

Report on Observance of World AIDS Day 2025

01st December, 2025

Broad Objectives:

1. Spreading awareness on AIDS among the marginalized section (Tea Garden Workers)
2. To make the students realize the importance of community engagement.
3. To contribute towards the upliftment of the marginalized and vulnerable sections of the society.
4. Networking with organisations and NGOs for Community Services.

Specific Objectives:

1. Creating Awareness on Prevention of AIDS.
2. Knowing the symptoms and the Manner of Spread
3. Become aware about detection and treatment of AIDS
4. Discuss the stigma associated with AIDS victim.

As per Government directives, a Community Extension Program was undertaken by Department of English, Duliajan College in collaboration with Tengakhat Block PHC to observe World AIDS Day on 1st December, 2025. The program was conducted in two phases.

Phase I- As a part of the program, Principal Dr. Lok Bikash Gogoi addressed the students and staff at the college premise with a short speech on the significance of World Aids Day. The Principal highlighted notable statistical data on relatively high numbers of AIDS patients in Assam and North-East in the recent years and emphasised upon the spreading of awareness about AIDS. The students of the English Department pinned red ribbons (symbol of solidarity, support, create awareness, anti-stigma associated with AIDS) to the faculties and other students to spread a general awareness on AIDS. A team consisting of the faculties of the Department of English, students and members of Duliajan College Students' Union was flagged off to carry out the Community Extension Program by the Principal to Dirial Central Hospital, Dirial.

Phase II- At Dirial Central Hospital an awareness program on AIDS was organized by Tengakhat Block PHC in collaboration with Department of English, Duliajan College. Senior Treatment Supervisor, Tengakhat Block PHC, Mr. Bhaskar Khanikar hosted the program where the invited guest speaker Mr Sraban Konwar, Counselor, ICTC, Naharkatia Co-District Hospital talked on the precautions, detection and treatment of AIDS. Additionally, Mrs Jyoti Singh Pathak, Vice Principal and HOD, Department of English, Duliajan College, spoke on necessity of knowing the symptoms of AIDS and encouraged the youth to take active part in creating awareness in the society. Dr. Mompi Sharma, Head of the Dirial Central Hospital was also present in the program. Students pinned red ribbons and took part in an awareness rally in the Dirial tea estate. They talked with the tea estate workers conveying about the seriousness of the disease and also distributed leaflets on the chief causes, symptoms and treatment of AIDS. The students were guided and counselled by the faculties and medical officials to engage actively throughout the program. The community extension program happened to be an interactive one with active participation from students, medical officials and estate workers.
